Notre Dame Place is a Clubhouse program where individuals who are experiencing a mental illness can become members. It provides an environment of support and encouragement that enables its membership to strive towards more meaningful and satisfying lives. It is a place of opportunity and of hope.

## What We Do

Notre Dame Place is a community-based program where participants are members, not clients.

The Clubhouse is based on a work-ordered day in which members choose their level of involvement in the different areas of the program. Members do not receive pay for work done in the clubhouse; however, they benefit from participating in meaningful work and developing positive relationships.
